Guilty of contravention of Rules 2(b),2(d),2(f) ,3(1)(a),3(1)(b) and 4(e) of the Rules of Conduct for Registered Persons promulgated under Board Notice 107, of 1997 Government Gazette number 18454 of 28 November 1997 and Board Notice 15, of 2006 Government Gazette number 28605 of 17 March 2006.

Sanction:

1. In terms of Section 32 (3)(a)(iii) the Respondent's registration is suspended for a period of 1 year, which suspension of registration is suspended for a period of 2 (two) years on condition that the Respondent is not found guilty of contravention of Rules 2(b),2(d),2(f) ,3(1)(a),3(1)(b) and 4(e) of the Rules of Conduct for Registered Persons or similar provisions of subsequent Rules of conduct, committed during the period of suspension.
