**UPDATE ON THE EXEMPTION APPLICATIONS IN RESPECT OF THE DRAFT IDENTIFICATION OF ENGINEERING WORK (IDOEW) REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINE PROFESSIONAL FEES, CASE # 2014 APRIL 0123**

It is common cause that the Competition Commission (CC) rejected both exemption applications in respect of the Draft Identification of Engineering Work (IDOEW) Regulations and Guideline Professional Fees.

The Council for the Built Environment (CBE) has appointed a firm of attorneys to advise all the six (6) Built Environment Professional Councils (BEPCs) jointly on whether to appeal or not, as well as on the legal aspects of the Competition Commission process.

The meeting with the said attorneys is scheduled for 6 May 2016.
