ECOSA OFFERS FREE REGISTRATION ON THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTER

The Engineering Council of South Africa (ECOSA) is calling on all Registered Professional Engineering Technicians to sign up on the International Register **FREE OF CHARGE**.

As a member of the International Engineering Alliance (IEA), ECOSA maintains an international register for Technicians, regulating the Agreement International Engineering Technicians (AIET). The agreement for international engineering technicians establishes an international benchmark competence standard for individuals practising as fully qualified engineering technician.

The concept of this agreement is that a person recognised in one country as reaching the agreed international standard of competence should only be minimally assessed (primarily for local knowledge) prior to obtaining registration in another country that is a party to the agreement.

This window of opportunity is only open to ECOSA professionally registered persons who meet the following minimum requirements:

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL REGISTER:

- An academic qualification accredited or recognised by ECOSA including those recognised through the relevant accords for the category
- Be a member of ECOSA in a relevant category
- Have a minimum period of two years in a position of responsibility in significant engineering work
- Maintain continuing professional development at a satisfactory level

- Access to an internationally recognised quality mark and enhanced credibility
